Registration Guidelines for Breeders

1. It is a condition of the Code of Ethics for cat breeders that all kittens must be registered, whether for breeding, showing or pet only.
2. Paperwork to be sent to the Registrar for processing must include a four generation pedigree. If both parents are already on the CFCCQ Inc. database, if in doubt contact the registrar.
3. Any incomplete paperwork will be returned by the Registration Committee noting what is required to complete the registration, any applications that do not contain the required fee will also be returned.
4. Any registration involving an interstate or overseas cat, i.e. an interstate stud or single cat registration for a cat purchased interstate or overseas must be accompanied by a certified pedigree and original registration from a recognised council.
5. A litter of litter kitten will only be registered in the prefix of the registered owner of the dam at the time the litter was born. Also, both the signature of the registered owner of the sire and dam must appear on the registration application. Kittens registered as altered will not be changed to entire.
6. The colour or pattern can only be changed prior to such a kitten being shown. Once the kitten or cat has been to a show, any colour or pattern reclassification must be accompanied by an assessment form completed by three judges.
7. A certified pedigree is not required for cats that are registered with recognised Queensland Councils.
8. New members of CFCCQ Inc are required to transfer all Breeding/show cats already registered in their name by another QLD council.
9. There will be a surcharge for any litter or litter kitten registration submitted after the kittens are six months old.

Although all care will be taken to ensure the accuracy of the registration documents, should any error be found, the registrar should be advised as soon as possible to make any corrections necessary. Any incorrect registrations **MUST** be returned to the Registrar with the mistakes noted on the incorrect pedigree, before a new pedigree will be issued.
