Companion Cats: During 2008 CFCCQ will be trialing a few different things with the Companion section of the shows. All Companions will be automatically entered into side class judging and all Companion exhibits will vie for the TOP CAT Award. Please also send with your entry of your Companion cat, a 25 word short story on how your cat came to be living with you.

Please Note: From 2008 onwards, it will be a requirement at ALL CFCCQ affiliated shows that pedigrees be sent in with entries. All photo copied pedigrees will be returned at the start of each show so that they can be reused for future shows.

DO NOT SEND ORIGINALS.

****All entries for kitten exhibits must include a copy of their current vaccination certificate with its sticker attached. No unvaccinated kittens are allowed to be shown at CFCCQ Inc shows.****

PLEASE NOTE: Exhibitors are NOT to use the car park between the hall and Wray Organics AT ANY TIME and especially not for leaving their cars while dropping off cats. Complaints have been received about car park blockages and loss of business. Please use the bays in front of the hall if you wish to drop cats and then park on the street or in the Reading Centre opposite the hall. NO parking will be allowed in front of the hall at future shows. This area is to be used only for dropping off cats. Please do NOT put any rubbish in the industrial bins in the car park as they are privately owned by the adjacent stores.

Classes - Definitions

Kitten: Entire, at least ten weeks old and under nine months on the day of the show. All kittens **MUST** be registered by four months of age.

Cat: Entire exhibits nine months or more on the day of the show.

Neuter: Male cat or kitten that has been altered.

Spey: Female cat or kitten that has been altered.

Litter: To consist of two or more kittens. All the living progeny of the one birth belonging to the one person or joint owners, not exceeding the age of four months on the day of the show. The number of kittens must be stated on the entry form.

Challenge

Class: The open class must be entered by all cats nine months and over. Cats are entered according to breed, colour and sex. Points are gained on all challenges. When a GDGC has 10 challenges awarded at CFCCQ Inc affiliated shows, it is eligible to become a "CFCCQ PDGC". PDGCs will then require 20 challenges to be elevated to CFCCQ Supreme Champion. All exhibits are eligible for Best in Show awards.

Companion Challenge

Class: All domestics over nine months now compete for Award of Merits. These can be used to title your companion.
